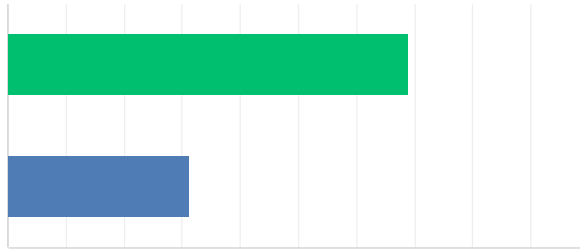

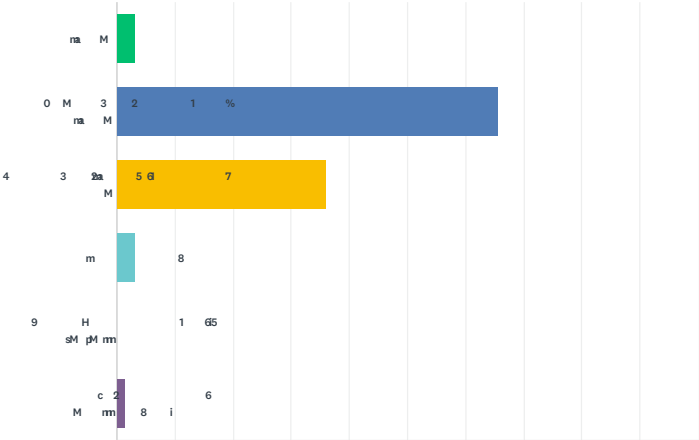

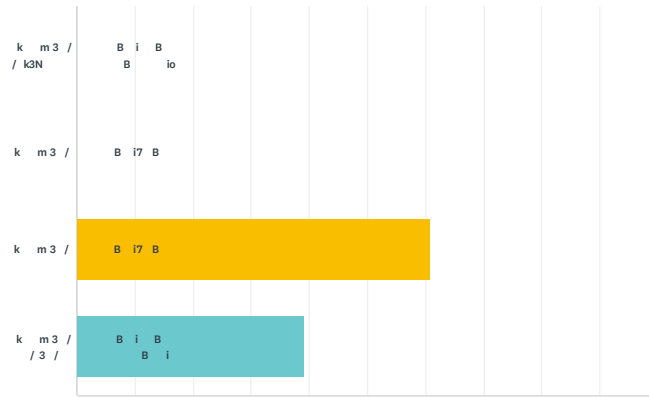

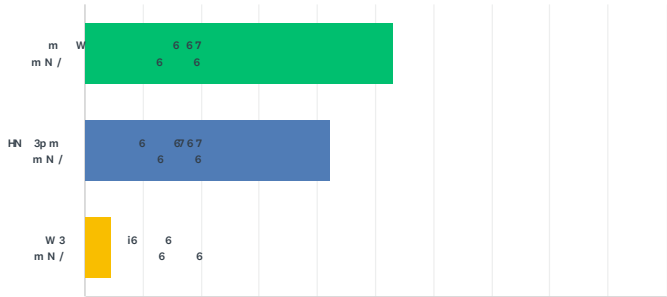

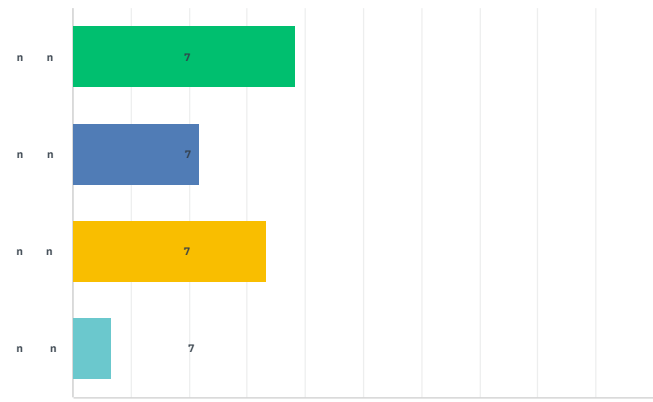

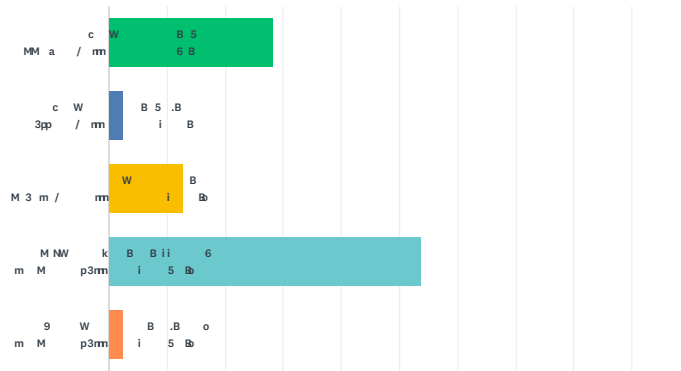

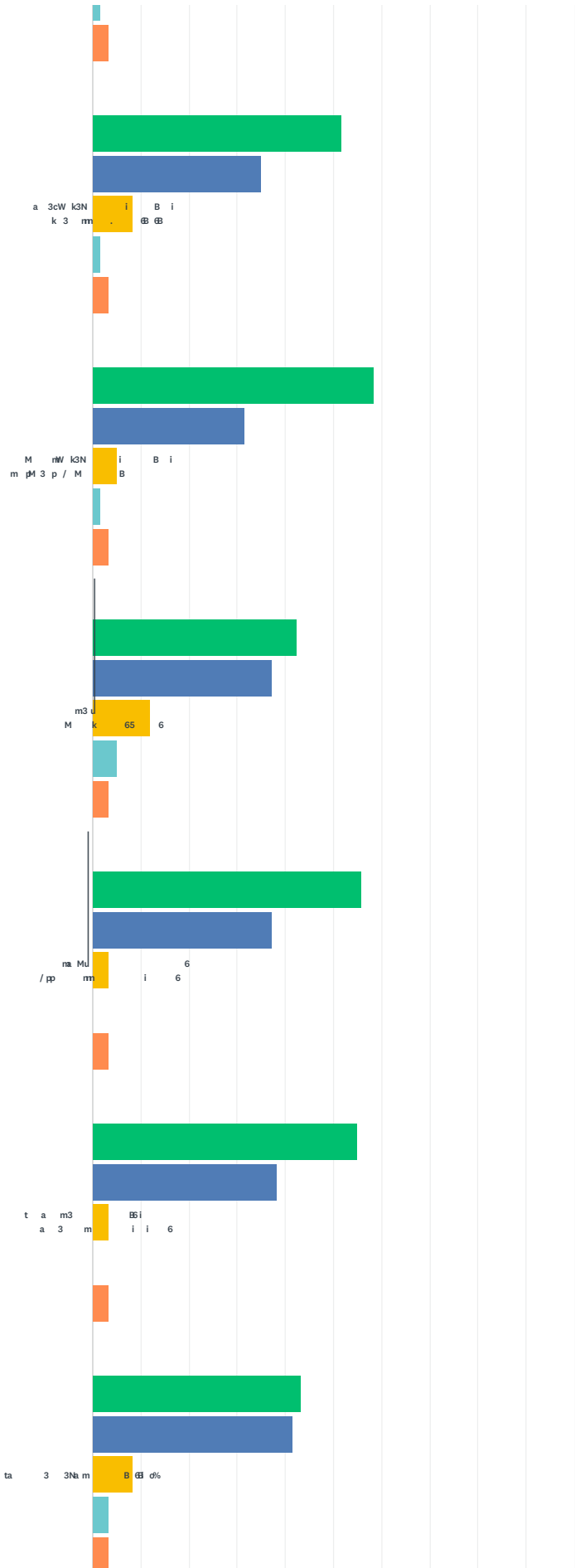

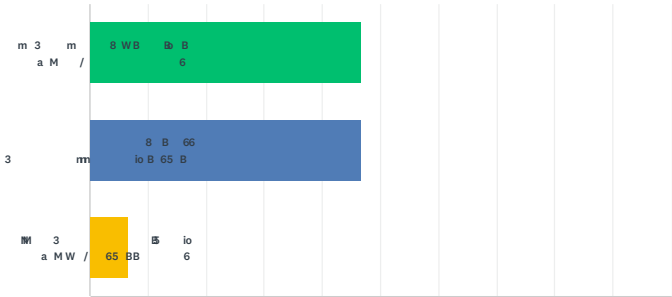
Q25 How long has it taken you to earn your degree?

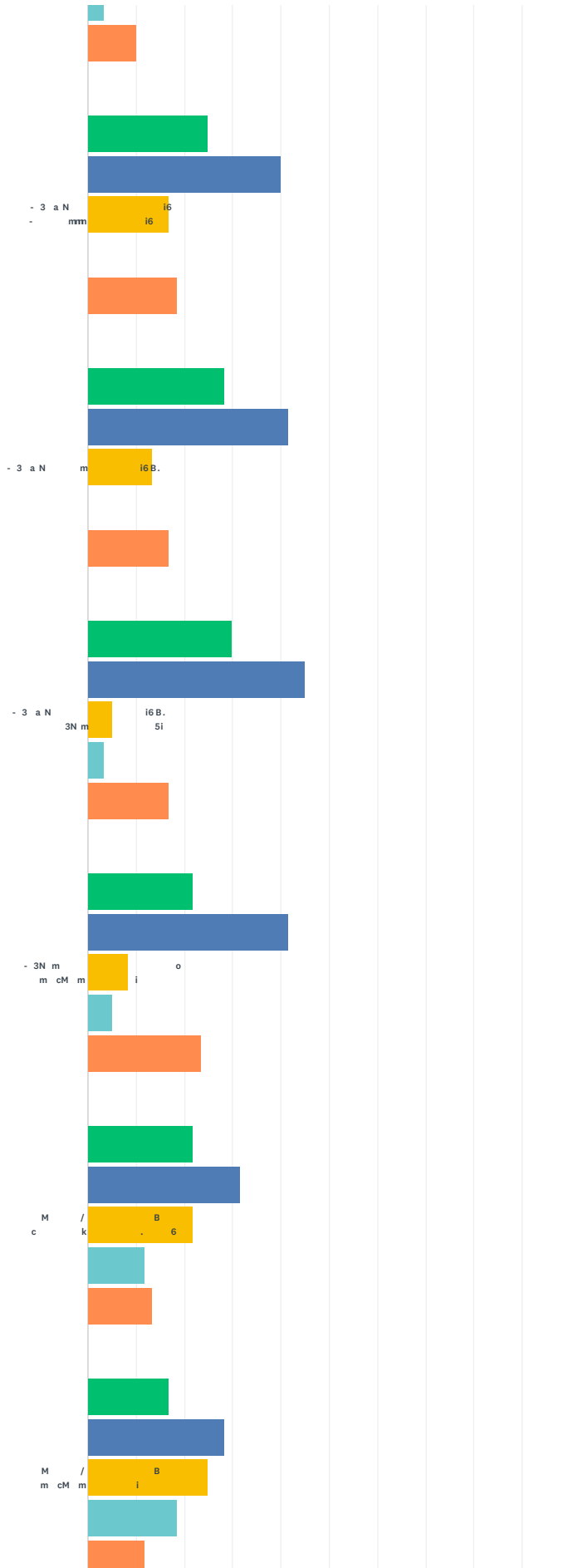

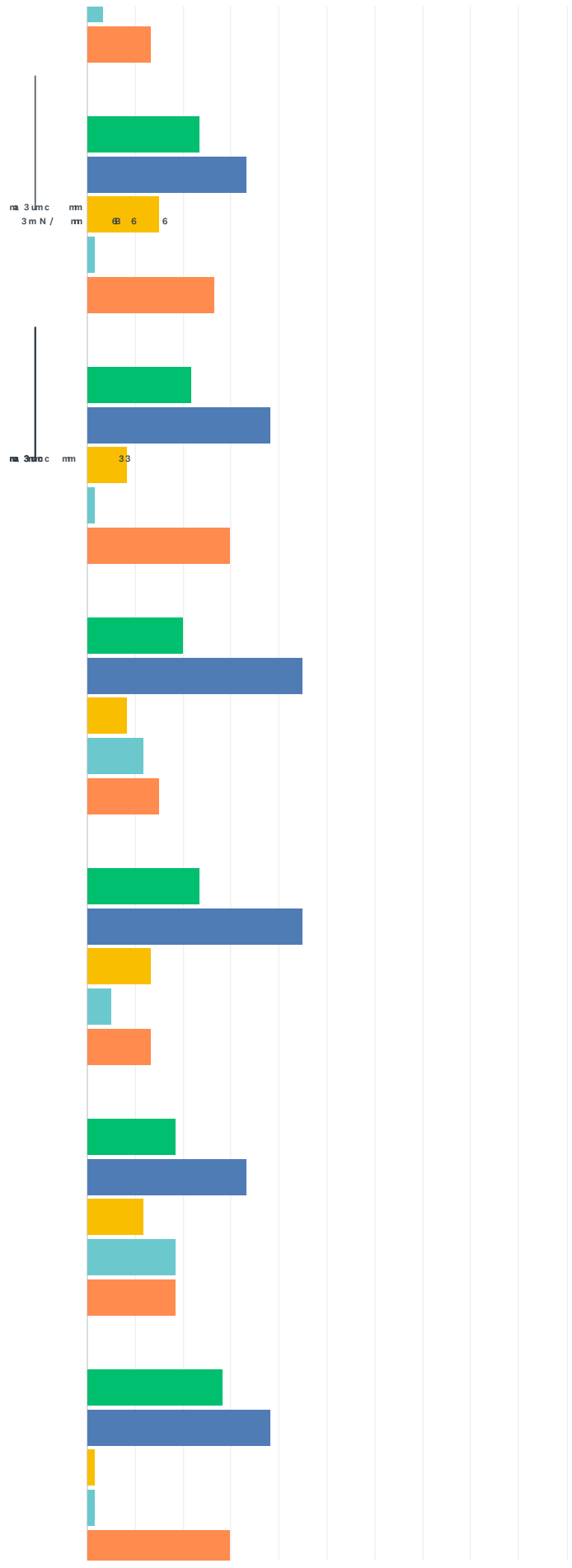

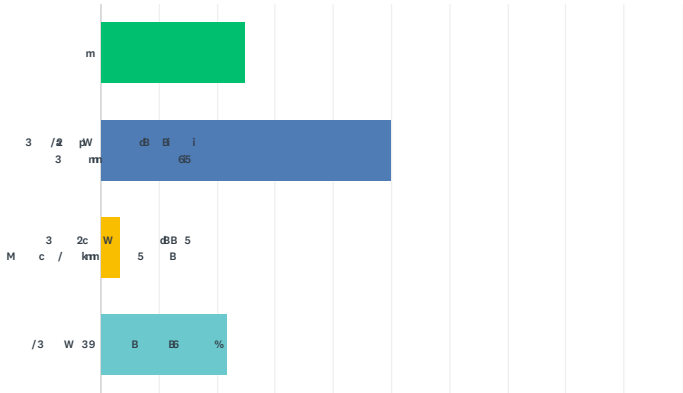
Q31 Indicate your level of satisfaction with the following aspects of your education at KSU

Q32 Would you continue your education at KSU?

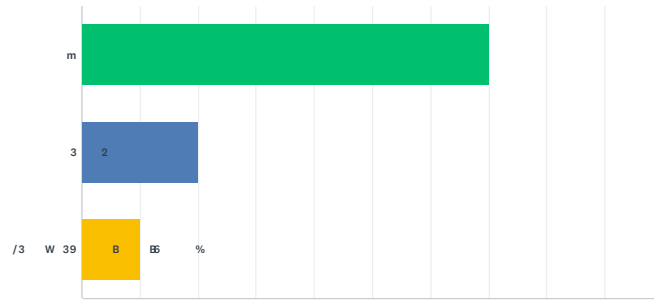

Q33 Is KSU a good value for the education that student receive?

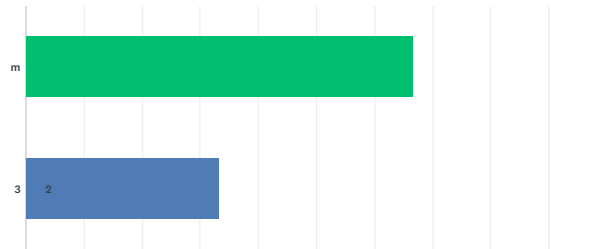
